Who may request an ethics consultation?

- Anyone experiencing an ethical dilemma may request an ethics consultation, including patients, family, staff and physicians.
- Permission is not required from leadership to request a consult.

When should I request an ethics consult?

- When there are seemingly irresolvable disagreements over ethical concerns.
- When there is a disagreement about whether an ethical dilemma exists.
- When you have tried to resolve the dilemma, but have not been successful.

How do I request an ethics consult?

- Call **811** or **1-306-655-5197** to be connected to your local ethics committee or an ethicist.
- Ethics consultants are available for consultation from 8am to 4pm, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays.
